As always, I am pleased to inform you that *The King's Men* (TKM) had an amazing month of May. During this past month, TKM passed the mark of 8 months of full-time outreach to men. May also brought with it our first ever attempt to unite and build men through a retreat experience. All of this could not be possible without your generous support!

Once again, TKM began the first Wednesday of the month with our fast for women (www.e5men.org) and our 10th stop on the No More Porn Tour. On May 2nd, TKM took the Tour back to the sexually oriented business (SOB) and franchise of "Adult World" on Rtes. 202 and 309 in Montgomeryville, PA. This stop marked the second time that TKM has taken the Tour to this SOB. You may recall that TKM staff and supporters successfully maintained a weekly protest of this SOB throughout the months of November and December '06 and January '07. The Warrior Brothers Weekend was a huge success! On Mother's Day weekend, over 55 men participated in what I project will be the launching pad of the Catholic men's movement in the United States. Co-Founder Damian Wargo and I along with a great team of 7 men facilitated this dynamic weekend at the beautiful Family Life Center in Malvern, PA. On the weekend, we united both single and married men from all over the country. One man, a deacon, traveled from Iowa. While another three men came from Chicago. One even trekked in from the great state of Ohio with the remainder coming from up and down the east coast. Why did they come? To learn about an authentically masculine and Catholic men's program called "The Warrior Brothers". This is a leadership and masculine development program exclusive to TKM. In partnership with Dr. Philip Mango, the Founder of Warrior Brothers, TKM will be sponsoring and organizing retreats like this for men throughout the year and God willing, for many years to come. Please pray for this special intention and that the funding will be available for this amazing program for men.
