TKM's experience indicates that as the number of men sharing the message of sexually purity and self-control increases in front of this SOB, the number of men entering decreases. TKM's WAR ROOM initiative has been meeting every 2nd Saturday of the month for the last 12 months. I am proud to say that our October 13th meeting marked the finalization of our plans to launch a new website www.pornfree711.com (11/17/07). We have also made plans to sponsor our first protest of a 7-Eleven that is not family friendly and in what we believe direct violation of PA statutes against the sale of soft-core pornography. This protest is set for Saturday November 17th at the 7-Eleven located on Horsham Road/Rte. 463 in Montgomeryville. The time for the protest is scheduled for 7-11 AM. Please join us if you can!

Another fruit of our WAR ROOM meetings is an opportunity to educate our community about how we can fight the harms of pornography.
